# THE MARCEL C. STANLEY COLLECTION

## OF NEW ZEALAND STAMP BOOKLETS : 1901 - 1990

Campbell Paterson Ltd. are pleased to be able to present over the next few months, a specialised, priced offering of the contents of the above collection, which, it has been suggested, stands among the finest of its type extant.

Due to the nature of the collection, the wide variety of issues covered over a ninety year period, the extreme rarity and value of some of the items, and the way the collection has been presented, it is intended not to offer the collection in one complete catalogue, but to deal with it section by section, through the C.P. Newsletter over forthcoming months.

Interested individuals and potential buyers should note that throughout the offering, the Campbell Paterson Catalogue listings - the most complete available today - will be used, and readers should refer to Section W in the Campbell Paterson Specialised Catalogue of New Zealand Stamps (Looseleaf).

### Description of the collection:

Made up over a period of fifty years by the late Mr Marcel C. Stanley, OBE, RPSL, RPSNZ, RDP, of Wellington. The largest section - and the only one formally mounted and entered for international exhibition - is the 1d Universal section (W1a to W02a). Other sections, from 1910 to the present, were presented in a less organised way, but nevertheless contain the makings of individual, highly specialised collections. A world expert on booklet collecting in the United States, who has viewed the collection recently, has stated that the 1d Universal section is as comprehensive and complete as any existing in the booklets of any other country.

It is proposed to offer the collection section by section, relating the offerings to the main definitive issues used to make up the booklets over the period. The 1d Universal collection will, in the first instance, be offered in its entirety subsequent to the commencement of the other "early" sections beginning in 1910.

This month, the listing commences with the Edward VII booklets (W3a and W3b) appearing between 1910 and 1914 in combination with the 1d Dominion issue.

We acknowledge the work carried out on this material by the late Prof. P.B.D de la Mare, of Auckland, who through his studies, was able to plate and otherwise identify much of the material in the following listing.

## 1910 - 1914 EDWARD VII BOOKLETS

**W3a 1910 April 2/- Booklet: Two panes of ½d Edward VII (H1a); 3 panes of 1d Dominion (J1a) stamps perf 14x15 wmk W7.**

**FIRST ELECTROTYPE BOOKLET PLATES - FIRST SETTING WITH NO BARS.**  
(Where possible, we give the plating position of booklet or panes.)

**BOOKLETS**

- B1 W3a. Exploded booklet (incomplete).** Outer covers and interleaving present, with two 1d Dominion panes and one (complete) ½d Edward VII pane. Staple rust stains and some gum discolouration on all panes but a useful specialist item and all three panes are facially clean and good examples. (Ornamental Star pane not included).
- Cat. \$1200, panes from middle row of sheet..... \$ 300

In W3a booklets, there were six stamps in the first ½d pane but only five stamps in the second ½d pane. The remaining space, either left if at the top of the pane or at right if at the bottom of the pane, was filled by an ornamental star in green.

- B2 W3a ditto.** Card cover with staple and all interleaving intact. This booklet contains one 1d Dominion pane and two stamps from one ½d Edward pane. Nice example of incomplete unexploded booklet (staining). Bottom row pane 22... \$ 35

**PANES**

- B3 (a) W3a(z) ½d Edward, no bars on selvages,** pane of six stamps from top row (number 6) unhinged, slight foxing. No bars on selvedge. Fine appearance - slightly blurred print..... \$ 75
- (b) Pane 16 as above,** but binding selvedge lightly hinged. Slight gum discolouration in some perfs. Nice fresh-looking pane, some adherence face of one stamp, plating notes accompany..... \$ 75
- (c) Pane 20.** Binding selvedge and two stamps slightly hinged and some parted perfs but magnificent-looking item..... \$ 125

- B4 W3a(y) ½d Edward ditto,** panes with ornamental stars - five stamps.
- (a) Pane 1,** star at top left. Binding selvedge cut down slightly and some hingeing and perf stains. Blurred pane; plating notes accompany. (Cat.\$1500) Nice example..... \$ 275
- (b) Another pane,** this time star at bottom-right and binding selvedge complete. Some perf stains but this is a magnificent-looking item..... \$ 300
- (c) As above - this time pane 24**..... \$ 300

**(d) Pane 23 : superb example from top row showing ornamental star at top left. Absolutely magnificent**..... \$1500

- (e) Part pane** in good condition (binding selvedge absent), blurred print, pane 16, including ornamental star at top left..... \$ 250

- B4 (f) Another piece, this time including block of four with ornamental star at top left, binding selvedge; from top row pane 5. Superb condition.. \$ 500
- (g) Used block of four with ornamental star at bottom right, postmarked Glenfield 3 Dec 1911. Superb used (no side selvedge or binding selvedge). \$ 375
- (h) Glorious horizontal pair with one stamp and ornamental star, left-hand side selvedge, used on commercial cover. Lovely item and very rare... \$ 500
- (i) Nice horizontal pair with ornamental star at left - lightly hinged..... \$ 300

# **PANES**

- B5 (a) W3a(x) 1d Dominion pane with no selvedge bars. Really superb pane with binding selvedge at top (middle row), no staining and pane fully intact. Superb..... \$ 400
- (b) Or pane from top row position 5, slight hingeing one stamp and binding selvedge crease..... \$ 275
- (c) Or pane 24, bottom row (binding selvedge not complete and staining)..... \$ 75
- (d) Ditto pane 23, this time binding selvedge complete:-staining. Magnificent appearance..... \$ 100

**W3b FIRST ELECTROTYPE BOOKLET PLATES - SECOND SETTING (WITH BARS), NO ORNAMENTAL STAR ON ½d PANES. 1912 PRINTINGS, 2/- BOOKLET.**

# **BOOKLETS**

- B6 (a) Complete booklet showing panes with bars at sides running through binding selvedge and "pair wide" binding selvedge bar, blurred prints. Superb example with full interleaving and covers, three panes of 1d Dominion, two panes of ½d Edward, (one slight perf stains)..... \$4000
- (b) Or W3b ditto booklet as above, this time from bottom row. Full interleaving and covers, one ½d pane removed. Blurred prints. Superb..... \$1250
- (c) Complete booklet again, description as above with full interleaving and covers and five complete panes. Unexploded condition, perfect..... \$4500
- (d) Example of covers and interleaving with stamps removed but most selvedges remaining, showing selvedge bars..... \$ 50
- B7 (a) W3b ditto, exploded booklet, pane no.1, including three panes of 1d Dominion and two panes of ½d Edward with side selvedge bars (no binding selvedge bars). All panes gum removed. Covers and interleaving all present (staple rust). Superb specialist material..... \$ 500
- (b) Or similar, this time exploded (pane 22). June 1912 date confirmed by presence of "Ford" advertisement. Superb appearance (no gum)..... \$ 500

- B10 (a) **W3b exploded booklet with one ½d pane and two 1d Dominion panes remaining. From position 19, booklet covers and interleaving present. Some staining in the ½d and staple rust stains in the two 1d panes. Gum removed. Useful study material. (Wellington ads).....** \$ 125
- (b) **W3b as above, advertising panes and some bits of selvages with one 1d Dominion stamp showing binding and side selvedge. Useful support material. (Dunedin ads).....** \$ 25
- (c) **W3b ditto, complete booklet with stamps removed but full interleaving and advertising as well as binding and side selvages. Interesting support material. (Wellington ads)....** \$ 25
- (d) **As above, this time exploded but all binding and side selvages present and advertising panes as well as cover. (Wgtn ads)...** \$ 25

**PANES**

- B11 (a) **W3b(y) ½d Green pane with full bars. Slight perf staining and hingeing but an excellent example of the pane - blurring. Cat. \$350, pane 1.....** \$ 150
- (b) **As above, this time pane 3, full bars slight staple rust and very minor toning. Beautiful example - blurred.....** \$ 250

(c) <b>Pane no. 4, as above, blurring and full bars, perfs parted in binding selvedge slightly, but this is a fine, clean pane.....</b>	<b>\$ 325</b>

- (d) **As above, pane no. 23, binding selvedge pair showing full barring.....** \$ 60
- (e) **On cover, dated 5 OC 14 to USA. Nice horizontal pair showing side selvedge bars, lightly marked, slightly torn flap.....** \$ 150
- (f) **Lovely used pane with binding selvedge cut down but side selvages intact with bars. Blurred print, used, at Apia, Samoa, 12 OCT 1914. From middle row of panes. Superb.....** \$ 300
- (h) **W3b(y) ½d pane as above, pane 19. Superb condition.....** \$ 350
- (i) **W3b(y) ½d as above, pane 23. Slight perf stains, fine looks.....** \$ 125
- (j) **½d pane 24, perfect condition, except that binding selvedge slightly torn.....** \$ 125
- (k) **½d top row pane 3 in perfect condition. blurred print.....** \$ 350

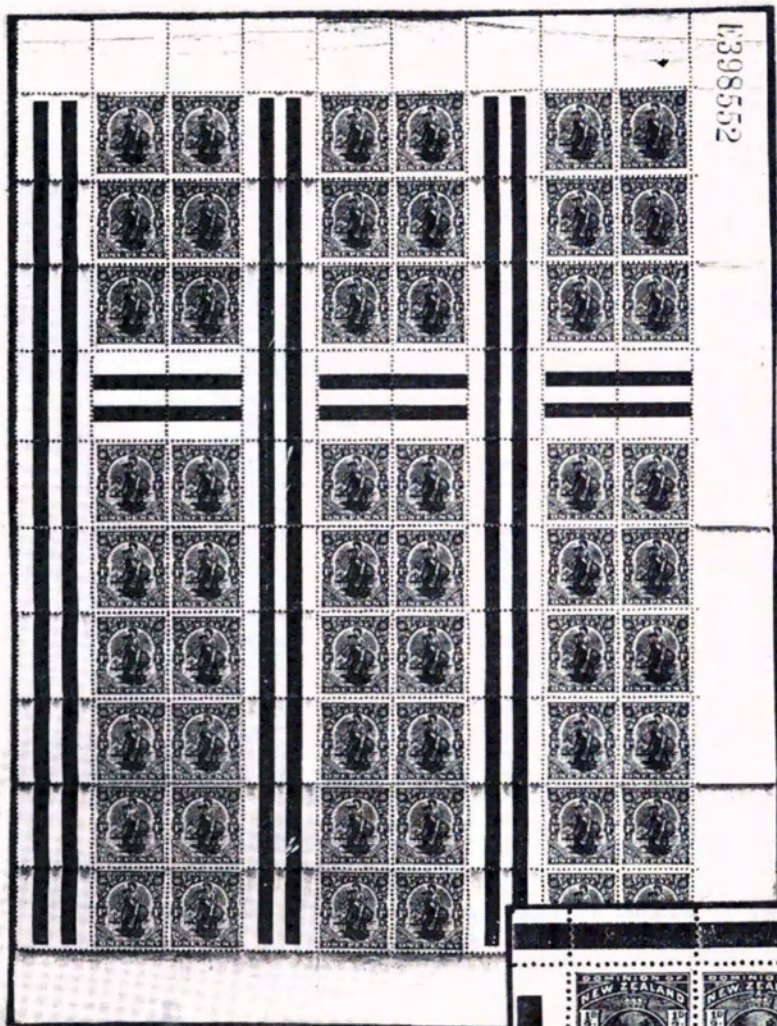
## PANES

- B12 (a) W3b(u) 1d Dominion, pane 17, full selvages with bars in excellent condition..... \$ 275
- (b) As above, pane 8. One stamp thinned and slight perf staining. Very blurred print. Side selvedge and part of serial no. present..... \$ 75
- (c) Selection of 1d material. Pane 6, very blurred, binding selvedge absent, good condition. Another pane, one stamp missing, this time pane 7. Pane 8 block of four, showing side selvages and part of serial number. Pane 1 binding selvedge and side selvages with horizontal pair stamps 1 and 2 blurred print. Interesting support material for exhibition entry and fully platable..... \$ 150
- (d) Pane 5, binding selvedge removed and without gum. However blurred pane shows full side selvages with bars..... \$ 30

**W3b SECOND ELECTROTYPE BOOKLET PLATES ½d EDWARD and 1d DOMINION.  
FEBRUARY TO MARCH 1915 PRINTING, FULLY BARRED.**

Note that the ½d Edward Green is identifiable in this printing by a flaw under the left-hand leg of the first "N" of PENNY in stamp position number 4 (all panes) and the 1d Dominion panes are identifiable by their presence in booklets with the Edwards.

- B13 (a) W3b. Complete exploded booklet, two panes of ½d and three panes of the 1d, in good condition, if binding selvages staple-rust stained. Exploded booklet with covers and full advertising interleaving included. Gum removed from panes. Full booklet catalogued at \$4500 - this is a scarce variation on the fully barred electrotpe printings. Some blurring in all panes..... \$ 375
- (b) W3b. Complete exploded booklet from middle row. Slight perf staining in all panes except one ½d Edward. Full covers and interleaving. This is a magnificent exhibition piece with full gum, if hinged in binding selvages. Magnificent.. \$2750
- (c) ½d Edward, pane no. 8. Magnificent item in perfect condition showing the "N" flaw in position 4..... \$ 400
- (d) Pane from middle row, showing flaw again and pair-wide bar in binding selvedge. Lovely example..... \$ 400
- (e) Commercially used pane without binding selvedge and a little staining, with some parted perfs. Nevertheless a wonderful example of this scarce 1915 printing..... \$ 175
- (f) Full covers and advertising interleaving from exploded booklet - no stamps..... \$ 50
- (g) As above (one ½d stamp present), but this time unexploded (pane 23)..... \$ 60
- (h) Unexploded (covers and interleaving). Some damage with remains of several panes. 1d Dominion (1); ½d (pair and single). Poor condition but interest ..... \$ 75
