THE MARCEL C. STANLEY COLLECTION OF NEW ZEALAND STAMP BOOKLETS: 1901 - 1990

Campbell Paterson Ltd. are pleased to be able to present over the next few months, a specialised, priced offering of the contents of the above collection, which, it has been suggested, stands among the finest of its type extant.

Due to the nature of the collection, the wide variety of issues covered over a ninety year period, the extreme rarity and value of some of the items, and the way the collection has been presented, it is intended not to offer the collection in one complete catalogue, but to deal with it section by section, through the C.P. Newsletter over forthcoming months.

Interested individuals and potential buyers should note that throughout the offering, the Campbell Paterson Catalogue listings - the most complete available today - will be used, and readers should refer to Section W in the Campbell Paterson Specialised Catalogue of New Zealand Stamps (Looseleaf).

Description of the collection:

Made up over a period of fifty years by the late Mr Marcel C. Stanley, OBE, RPSL, RPSNZ, RDP, of Wellington. The largest section - and the only one formally mounted and entered for international exhibition is the 1d Universal section (W1a to W02a). Other sections, from 1910 to the present, were presented in a less organised way, but nevertheless contain the makings of individual, highly specialised collections. A world expert on booklet collecting in the United States, who has viewed the collection recently, has stated that the 1d Universal section is as comprehensive and complete as any existing in the booklets of any other country.

It is proposed to offer the collection section by section, relating the offerings to the main definitive issues used to make up the booklets The 1d Universal collection will, in the first over the period. instance, be offered in its entirety subsequent to the commencement of the other "early" sections beginning in 1910.

This month, the listing commences with the Edward VII booklets (W3a and W3b) appearing between 1910 and 1914 in combination with the 1d Dominion issue.




