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## N.Z. NOTES AND COMMENT

**7c POSTAFIX PROVISIONAL FORGERY.** Mr. Kendall of London has shown us a postally used copy of the 3c Moth stamp with a surcharge purporting to be that applied to this value for use in "Postafix" appliances.

This is evidently a forgery, and a very crude one. Apart from the fact that it is printed in black, and consists of a rectangle obliterating the original value with the new value '7c' below, the surcharge on Mr. Kendall's copy bears little resemblance to the normal. The ink used has a dull flat appearance (in the genuine, it is distinctly glossy); it also lacks body, and shows a tendency to smear. By far the most outstanding dissimilarity, however, lies in the size of the value. The '7' is 3mm in height, the 'c' is 2mm, as opposed to 4½mm and 3mm respectively in the genuine. The actual difference is much more pronounced than these measurements might suggest — the forgery appears positively tiny.

All known genuine "Postafix" provisionals are on unwatermarked paper, but Mr. Kendall's stamp is from the earlier watermarked 3c printings. If others exist (and this seems highly probable) they could obviously include unwatermarked examples.

Most modern forgeries have been perpetrated with a view to deluding the unsuspecting collector. In this instance, however, that seems an improbable motive, since the genuine stamp has no specially enhanced value in the philatelic world. The logical conclusion, therefore, is that its purpose is to defraud the N.Z. Post Office of revenue, by reducing someone's postage bill by more than 50%, and if that is the case, the chances are that the forgeries will have been produced in considerable quantities.

The authorities must be aware that they run this risk if they choose to enhance the value of a common stamp, especially by means of a surcharge which is itself rather a crude piece of work. The risk is greatly increased of course when an overnight rise of well over 100% in ordinary postage rates (which occurred fairly recently in N.Z.) makes the exercise that much more attractive to the would-be swindler.

**King George V.** Anyone researching the record of fresh discoveries in the K.G.V. recess-printed issues might be excused for concluding that potential interest begins and ends with the 4d. With

very few exceptions indeed, this value has for long held a virtual monopoly on new finds (most if not all of which, incidentally, have been first reported in either the Woking Bulletin or the Auckland Newsletter).

But appearances can deceive, and as proof of that fact we this month list two further notable and unrecorded varieties, both being on values other than the 4d:

(i) A fine re-entry on the 3d. Doubling is widespread throughout the design, but is particularly noticeable in the letters NW of NEW, in the O of POSTAGE, in the scrollwork at the left, around the King's ear, and in the diamond ornaments at the top. Examples have been seen perf. 14 x 13½ (in a block of 4), and on 'Pictorial' paper (in a pair). Precise sheet position and plate are unknown, but the block — a top marginal one — locates the re-entry to the first horizontal row, and the marginal watermark inscription suggests that it occurs on stamp no. 3.

(ii) Another good re-entry, this time on the 6d. Again plate and position are unknown, the only example seen being in a non-marginal block — incidentally in a superb carmine-rose shade. However, plate wear (slight but definite) and paper (the earlier Cowan unsurfaced, not the esparto) both indicate the variety is on one of the original plates, i.e. 22 or 23. Doubling appears to be confined to a narrow horizontal band across the centre of the design, taking in the scrollwork at both sides, and the King's ear, all of which are clearly duplicated. It should be noted that this is not the only 6d re-entry known. Another (Plate 23 R1/12) is described in Vol. 1 of the Handbook.

**Late again.** Recent behind-the-scenes problems with issue dates continue to plague the N.Z.P.O. The 'Agricultural College' set, originally due to be placed on sale on April 5th, did not appear until three weeks later on the 26th. At the time of writing, we know of no official explanation for the delay. Could it be that there were second thoughts in high places about letting the set see the light of day at all? Certainly the designs are uninspired to say the least. Paradoxically that, coupled with the unprecedentedly high face value (totalling \$1.03), may make this one of the key sets of the future, by severely curtailing the numbers purchased while it is current.
