INTRODUCTION

The booklets of current stamps sold in New Zealand Post Offices make up one of the most interesting studies of the 1970 Pictorial (Definitive) issue. As will be shown, it was possible for me to deduce from the evidence available at Post Office Headquarters, Wellington, the positions of each of 25 booklet panes, which go to make up each the entire sheets of the three values present in the booklets before they are guillotined. In each of these panes, I have identified certain characteristics a list of which will be found in the following pages. Certain background information is necessary and the following notes should be read carefully before attempting to use the notes.

GUIDE TO TERMS USED

"PANE" – The small sheets of stamps (usually 6) found in the booklets as they are sold in the Post Office.

"SHEET" – The original form in which 25 panes are produced from the printing cylinder. The "sheets" are later guillotined to produce 25 separate "panes".

"ADVERTISEMENT PANE" each booklet contains interleaving and panes carrying advertisements which are printed on both sides. The following research applied only to the "facing" sides.

"SEWN" – The panes in each booklet are sewn together down the left hand edge of the booklet.

BOOKLET LAYOUT

Each booklet contains 5 panes of stamps. This includes 2 identical 4 cent panes. Interleaving and advertisement panes divide the panes of stamps from each other. Each sheet is made up of 25 panes in a 5 x 5 format. The advertisement panes are printed on yellow unsurfaced paper – by lithography in colours black and green.

The original sheets of stamps are printed by photogravure and are perforated with a double comb head, working from bottom to top of the sheet.

After the sheets of stamps have been printed they are brought together in a set order and interleaving and advertisement sheets of the same format and size are collated with them. The block of sheets thus obtained is then sewn together vertically down the vertical gutters between the rows of panes making up the sheets. It is then that the block of complete sheets is guillotined vertically and horizontally to produce the completed booklets. The panes of stamps in each booklet are made up as follows:– 1 cent (six stamps), 1c (3 stamps), 3c (6 stamps), 4c (two panes, each of 6 stamps).

THE METHOD USED TO PLATE THE BOOKLETS

As complete unguillotined examples of the advertisement sheets, containing 25 panes each, were available for scrutiny at Post Office Headquarters, Wellington, I arranged to have them examined for identifying flaws and plate marks and extracted a list of these. This enabled me to recognise each advertisement pane in its guillotined form in the Booklets, and "plate" it – that is, place it in its correct position in the original sheet of advertisements. It was necessary to make sure that all these identifying flaws were constant and common to all advertisement sheets.

Once each complete booklet was, by this method, able to be plated, it followed that **each pane of stamps** in the complete booklets, could be plated, as, in the original sheets, the panes of stamps occupy the same positions as the panes of advertisements. Extensive research was carried out on booklets from all over New Zealand to verify the evidence obtained by the method described above.

THE USE OF THE NOTES IN PLATING THE BOOKLET PANES

(1) Each complete sheet of booklet panes, before guillotining contains 25 panes (5 rows of 5). For convenience in this summary they are numbered 1 to 25, moving left to right across the sheet and starting with the top row.

(2) Each stamp in each pane has been allotted an identifying number from 1 to 6. The stamps are numbered moving left to right starting with the upper row of stamps. Thus "stamp 6" is the third stamp from the left in the second row.

(3) Each flaw, retouch or plate defect used to identify individual stamps in each booklet pane is located by the use of the "Thirkell" position finder. This is a grid-type device with letters on one side and figures on the top side. Such positions are designated "Th. E.4." etc. These position finders are available from Campbell Paterson Ltd. at 60c plus postage.
