Boer War One Penny Postal Stationery Cards

- This short display will show all the 16 cards that were issued in 1900 depicting scenes associated with the Boer War.
- Several varieties have been recorded on the cards, no stop after SIDE, PQSTAGE for POSTAGE, exclamation mark removed. There appear to be couple more that are noteworthy.
- The A in Address is progressively broken through the printing on the different types of card and evident on all scenes. The i in side is broken in the middle and occurs on most scenes.
