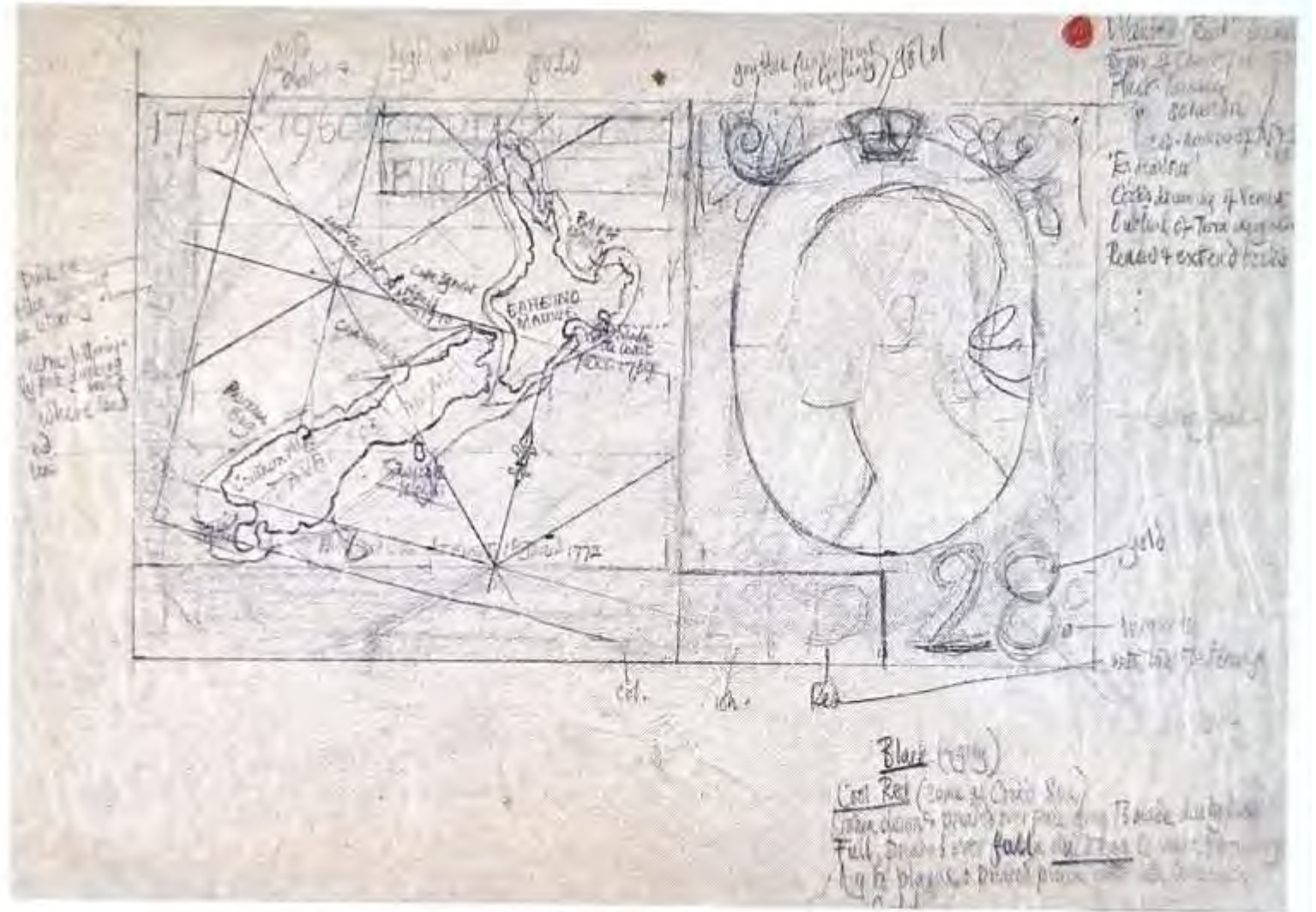

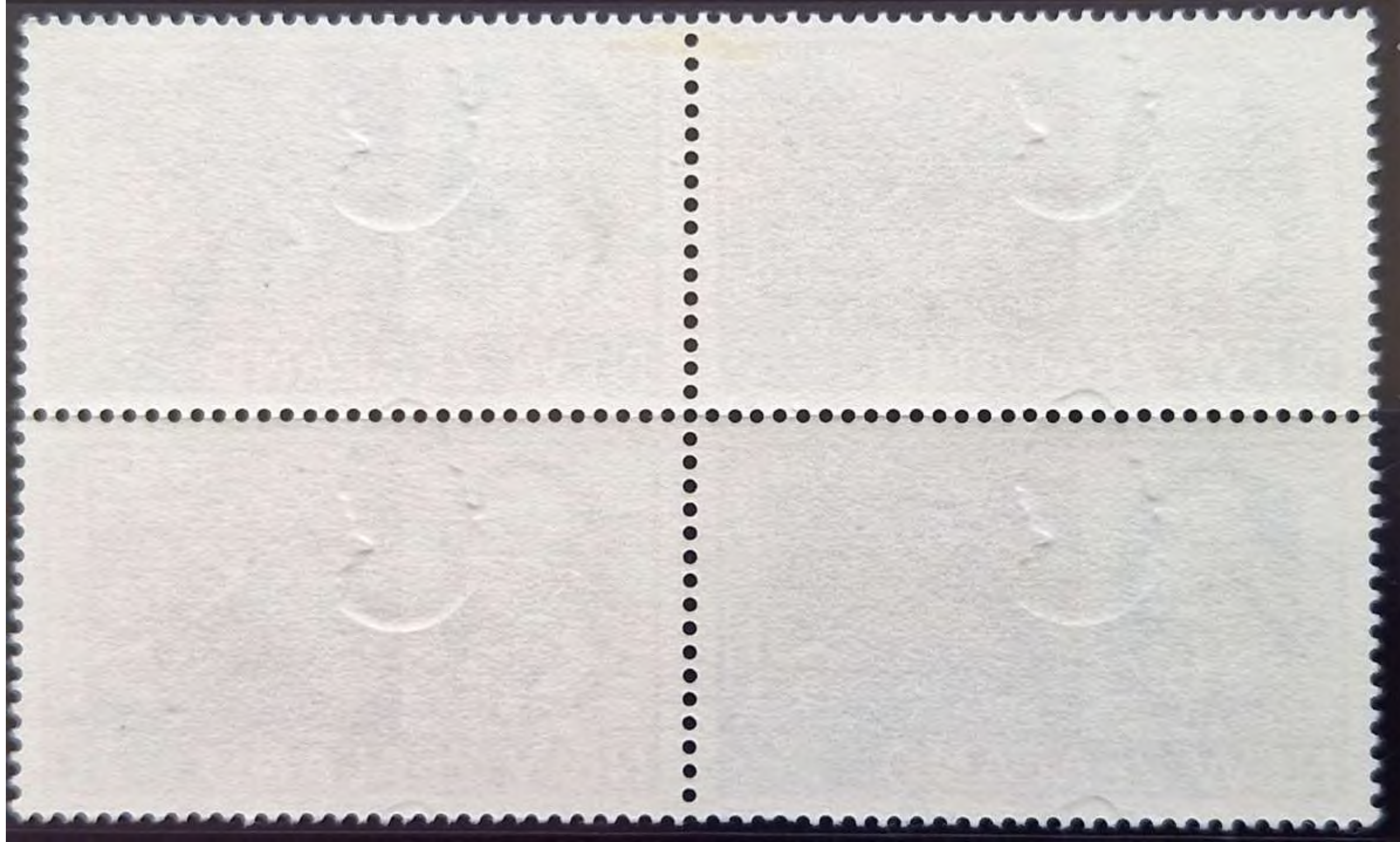

- Cordial relations between the crew and the biologists were reported.
- A resultant book was published. 2 copies in Royal Society and each member received one copy. An enquiry into purchasing a copy was rejected.
